Shoreham Village is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors.

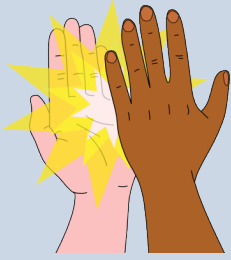
