Main Entrance Revitilization

The next project we are looking to undertake is the relocation of the main entrance to where the original main entrance was located when the facility was built. We have a larger renovation planned for the main entrance with the full building renewal, which has not been approved to date. The scope of this first phase of the project would be only a portion of that full plan. There would be a small addition to the current infrastructure to create a larger vestibule with scoping doors and a small overhang to protect residents and families entering the building from weather. These doors have been proven in other long term care facilities to improve resident comfort and bring significant heating/cooling savings.

There are some repairs included for the deck area which is a favorite sitting area for residents in the summer. This would also address the accessibility of the entrance. The entrance would then be in the middle of the facility opening to our main lobby as per the original building design. The project would include updating the reception and office areas. We have received a grant from the municipality to contribute to the cost of this project along with a private donation and the support of the Shoreham Village Foundation. At this time we have conceptual design completed and pictured below.
