HAPPY HOLIDAYS

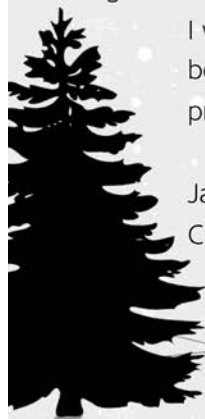

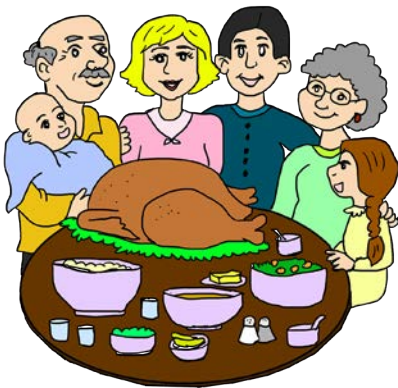
Christmas Dining Update

The province recently announced the creation of Regional Care Units (RCUs) to care for Long Term Care (LTC) residents that test positive with COVID-19. The province has also designated some LTC homes as Care in Place.

Shoreham Village has been designated as a Care in Place home. This allows the staff who know your loved ones

the best to continue caring for them if they test positive for COVID-19. We have created dedicated space for this purpose and are ready should it be required. Resident safety remains our top priority.

We are following all Public Health protocols and are doing all we can to keep residents safe.




Shoreham Exterior Project Update

We are so excited about the progress we have made to the exterior of our building. The new windows have now been installed in the identified areas except for one. The crew is now able to complete the re-shingling of the walls where new windows were installed. Rain gutter installation has begun. The project is approximately 85% complete and scheduled to be completed by the end of March. This project is funded by the Department of Health and Wellness.
