Here is an update for you from the Golf Tournament:

We are still waiting for two sponsorship payments, one is being paid by cheque by the Municipality and teh otehr has requested to pay by e-transfer.

I've been advised by Tammy to make one e-transfer to finance@shoreham.com and am waiting for the outstanding payment before transferring the outstanding funds raised of \$695 for a total of \$1195.

We had many generous donations for prizes, the biggest being \$300 of lobster donated by Zink Fisheries! The donated signed Brad Marchand Jersey fetched \$600 in funds raised! Maybe next year I can secure a Panthers or Leafs Jersey?

We had some Residents join us at registration to greet the golfers and have some Tim Hortons and then some residents joined us at lunch and received a warm welcome from the crowd.

The Birdease website expires July 4th if you would like to renew it, it costs \$299/ year. It is easy to use. The data can be downloaded before that and all the invoices downloaded and saved incase folks loose their copy of the invoice.

Chester Golf Course were gracious hosts. They were generous with their time and resources. We had 74 golfers registered, one team not show up and CGC put in a team as well as donated 8 passes as prizes.

I still have Thank you letters to go out to the donations and another round of Thank you emails with invoices to the players. I would like to connect with Shoreham and Northwood to do a large Thank you round up Post highlighting sponsors, community prizes etc.

Could we include something like that on the website or newsletter as well?

I enjoyed being able to help a community of people that have been present in my life growing up in Hubbards and going to school in Chester. This tournament is a big undertaking and requires and deserves a great deal of attention and time.

I do not think that I am that person in this present season of my life going forward. I am more than happy to help support future fundraising initiatives by way of volunteering, fundraising, gathering donations etc.
